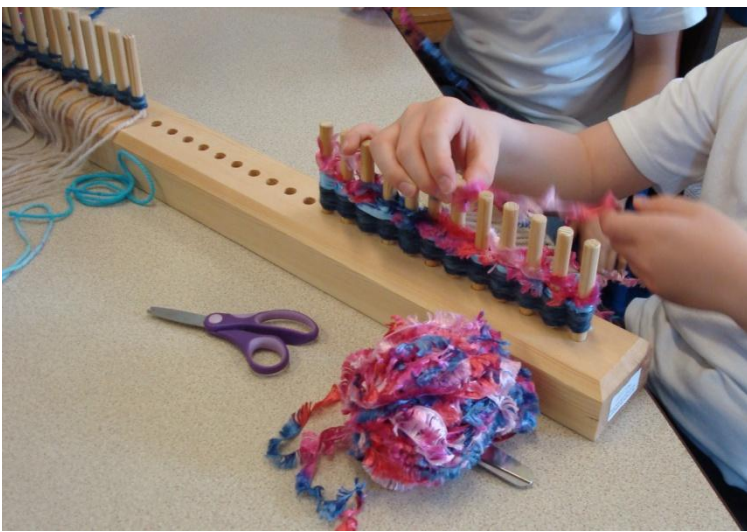




**Peg Loom Weaving Project
Broomley First School, Stocksfield, July 2010**

This weaving project was carried out with Year 2 and Year 4 pupils. The aim was to produce a hanging which evoked a sense of the open Northumberland landscape surrounding the school.

Pupils worked in pairs at each end of the loom. Fabrics and wools were sorted into three colour ranges – greens, blues and rustic reds/browns. Pupils selected from one colour category to produce a section of weaving.



Pupils embellished their work by attaching beads, sequins and textile wrapping. Finally all the pieces were sewn together to produce a visually stunning, highly textured wall hanging.
