



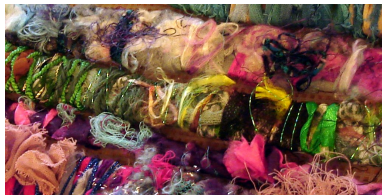
Workshop Information Sheet

Silk Paper Making



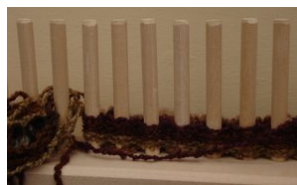
One day workshop learning the art of Silk Paper making using silk fibres. The silk fibres are combined with other fibres to create a 'silk paper' that can be used to make cards, be incorporated with other textiles to make bags, purses etc. The finished silk paper can also be moulded around shapes to form bowls and other objects. An iron is used in this process.

Textile Wrapping



One day textile wrapping workshops using a wide range of textiles, fibres and recycled materials to create images such as landscapes, jewellery and 3D objects using wire, card and other flexible material as a base.

Peg Loom Weaving



A one day workshop weaving with a Peg Loom enables the weaver to create wonderful wall hangings, rugs, bags, scarves and more with a wide range of wools, yarns and other fibres.

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Examples of Themed Workshops

3D Sculptural Felt Making

One day workshop creating a vase, bowl or bag using sculptural felt making techniques.

Sitting Pretty - Hooky & Proggy - Two Days - beginners to intermediate

Two day workshop making a cushion cover using a wide range of materials and recycled fabrics.

Flat Form Felt Making

Create a wonderful felted landscape or picture to create a wonderful unique book cover.

Recycling - Taster or One Day - beginners to intermediate

Using plastics, net bags, foil wrappers from crisp and sweets packets etc.

Collages for Wall Hangings - One or Two Days - intermediate to advanced - Silk Paper Making, Textile Wrapping

Use combinations of material and fabric to make collages and wall hangings such as: tough plant fibres; shells; mirrors; plastics; foil wrappers; wools; velvets and synthetic materials.

Inspiration from the Natural Landscape - Hooky & Proggy; Textile Wrapping; Felt Making; Painting; Peg Loom Weaving - Two Days - but would suit a 'Summer School' week. Use the natural landscape for inspiration for rugs, paintings, wall hangings and collages such as: stones; lichens; mosses; fossils; landscape.

Rocks and Landscape in Fabrics and Fibres - Hooky & Proggy; Textile Wrapping; Felt Making; Peg Loom Weaving

A creative day interpreting the North Pennine landscape with felt, silk paper-making, the traditional craft of hooky & proggy and Peg Loom weaving. Be inspired by the stunning local landscapes, rocks, fossils and minerals of the Region.

Advanced Techniques - One or two days

Expanding on the basic hooky and proggy, painting and sculptural felt making techniques and other decorative effects with materials, fabrics and fibres.

Ten Week Courses

Would run the same outline programme as per the one and two day courses, but would be paced over the 10 weeks.

Summer Schools

One week residential courses covering a range of subjects: rug making; collages; wall hangings; painting and felt making advanced techniques - incorporating the above; recycling.
